

Field Chooser

You can select which columns to be shown by pressing this button, it will pop up a Field Chooser window:

- Removing the following columns will have a positive effect on performance:
 - Postponed**
 - Shipper**
 - Consignee**
 - Validity + Valid pin** (need to be removed together to have effect)
 - Reference + ETS + Full in reference** (need to be removed together to have effect)
 - Driver + Supplier + Order status** (need to be removed together to have effect)
 - EC Line/Fleet + EC Status + EC Date + EC Time** (need to be removed together to have effect)
- **PLEASE NOTE: removing these columns will prevent their values being retrieved. Therefore the grid needs to be refreshed when one of these columns is added to the grid again**
- You can add or remove columns by clicking on the checkbox, double click on the name or press the spacebar in the Field Chooser
- You can use the cursor keys up and down to cycle through the columns. Holding the shift key will select multiple columns at once. Use CTRL-A to select or deselect all columns at once. Pressing spacebar will add or remove all selected columns in the grid
- You can drag columns from the Field Chooser to the grid and insert them directly on the preferred position. This is also an effective way for reordering your columns (dragging a column that is already in the grid will move that column to the new position)
- You can drag columns from the grid to the Field Chooser to remove them from the grid

Grouping

You can drag columns to the grouping header to group rows together:

It will show a treeview where rows are grouped together that have the same value for a grouped column. You can make sub groups by dragging more columns to the group header

Sorting

You can click on column headers to change the sorting, the triangle will indicate ascending or descending:



- Click on a column header to switch between ascending and descending sorting on that column
- Keep the SHIFT key pressed to sort on multiple columns (rows with the same value for the first sorting will be sorted subsequently on the second sorting)

Filtering


You can filter on values in a certain column by clicking on the funnel icon (it will be blue if a filter is active):



A list of options will be shown, at the bottom you will find all values currently present in the grid for that column

- Click on one of the possible values (for example 'SENT' in the above screenshot) to have the grid only show rows with that value
- The option (Blanks) will show all rows that have a value for that column, (NonBlanks) will show rows without a value for that column
- Choose the (All) option to remove filters for that column
- Choose (Custom) if you want to make a more advanced filter, for example if you want rows with several values for that column (for example rows with status NEW or TO BE PLANNED).


In the popup screen you can:



1. Choose what type of filter (equals, greater than etc.)
2. Enter a value for that filter
3. Optionally add additional filters
4. When using more than 1 filter: apply filters to show rows that satisfy **All** filters (filter 1 AND filter 2 AND ...) or show rows that satisfy **Any** filter (filter 1 OR filter 2 OR ...)

PLEASE NOTE: filtering has only a visual effect. If a row is selected and applying a filter would hide that row, the row is still selected (the information shown in the yellow frame for example is still from that row)

All filters can be removed at once by clicking this button:



Fixed columns

Clicking on the pin icon on a column header will make that column fixed on its position when you scroll right and left. This can help to keep certain information visible in the screen when looking for columns that are currently out of the screen.

Since the pin icon and funnel icon are a bit close together you can show or hide the pin icon with the pin button:



All fixed columns will be shown at the left side of the grid. You can also use the Field Chooser to drag columns to and from the fixed columns section.

Grid layout

The order and size of columns, as well as filters, grouping, sorting and fixed columns can be stored. Use this button to save the current layout:



The layout for Single trips, Rail & barge and Voyage currently all use the same layout (saving it in one place will affect the other grids as well).

The layouts for the delivery and collection grids for Combinations can be stored individually. Initially the Single trips layout will be used.

If a layout somehow causes problems it can be deleted with this button:
